





# DRESSED IN EDELWEISS

M O R I T Z   G A M P E R

**Moritz Gamper, originally from Meran and now based in Vienna, releases *Dressed in Edelweiss* – his second studio album and first multilingual work.**

Gamper unfolds a new sonic universe rooted equally in his South Tyrolean heritage and his international musical influences. The record is a collision of cultural contexts – defined in terms of language and genre, yet deliberately playful. Blues, Jazz, Folk and Singer-Songwriter elements intertwine just as naturally as English, South Tyrolean dialect, French and Italian.

The title *Dressed in Edelweiss* carries a certain nonchalance and leaves room for interpretation. There is a touch of irony to it, but far more a deeper reflection: the edelweiss may be the archetypal symbol of Alpine tradition, yet here it seeks to reinvent itself – shedding the worn-out associations for something more elegant and subtle.



ABOUT THE MUSIC Virtuoso jazz trumpets, smooth double bass lines and a bluesy harmonica - always paired with Gamper's distinctive voice, which appears here more relaxed and self-assured than ever, moving effortlessly between dialects. Every line, every verse, every mood is free to choose its preferred language.

Anyone expecting Alpine clichés in line with the title's symbolism will be sorely disappointed. While the album plays with those associations, and the dialect points in that direction, the imagery it conjures is closer to a chic New York jazz club than a folk music variety show. Alpine goes international.

Dressed in Edelweiss represents a distinct musical world that carries Gamper's South Tyrolean identity while presenting it in a way unlike any other Alpine artist. Gamper wants to provoke thought - perhaps even stir things up a little - but above all invites the listener to immerse themselves in this new world and lose themselves in its music.
